The AAT qualification

The Association of Accounting Technicians (AAT) is globally recognised, and the perfect introduction to your accountancy career. It's designed for those starting out in accounts, or who are currently working in finance and want to improve their skills.

You'll obtain skills that will open doors for your career progression: being AAT qualified gives you the expertise demanded by employers. This qualification also offers students the opportunity to gain full membership of the AAT.

Students need to achieve competence in all units to gain the certificate.

Enrolling with InterActive

Once you have registered with AAT and you have your confirmation number, you can enrol with InterActive and start studying your AAT course right away.

If you purchase all papers from levels 2 and 3, InterActive will pay your exam fees and register you with an exam centre*. If you decide to purchase individual papers only, you will have to complete the registration process yourself.

You must make sure you meet all of AAT's entry requirements. For AAT level 2 there are no formal entry requirements; however, it is recommended that students have a good command of English and Mathematics. For AAT Level 3, students are required to have one of the following: A-level in accounts, AAT certificate in accounting level 2, or 2-3 years prior accounting experience. If you would like to learn more about entry requirements, exemptions or anything else, please visit the AAT website.

Exemptions:

There is a standard list of exemptions from AQ2013 if students have completed papers from ACCA, City and Guilds, and International Association of Bookkeepers.



AAT syllabus & exam regulations

The AAT Level 2 & 3 syllabus consists of 11 units divided into 2 levels:

8 computer-based tests

3 computer-based projects

The AAT Level 2 syllabus for each unit:

PBKT: Processing bookkeeping transactions

CJBS: Control accounts, journals and the banking system

BCST: Basic costing

WKAF: Working effectively in accounting and finance

CPAG: Computerised accounting

The AAT Level 3 syllabus for each unit:

ACPR: Accounts Preparation

CSTR: Costs and Revenues

TAX: Indirect Tax

PETH: Professional Ethics

FSTP: Prepare Accounts for Sole Trader and Partnerships

SDST: Spreadsheet software

Exams

- Exams are computer based and can be taken at any time during the year. Please contact InterActive when you are ready to sit your exam, and we will register you with one of our exam centers in London, Manchester or Birmingham. Or if you wish you can find a local AAT exam centre in your area by visiting www.aat.org.uk
- Students need to achieve competence in all units to gain the certificate.
- Access to the course will be available for a maximum of 12 months.
